PASSPORT – U.S. citizens traveling abroad must have a valid passport. Apply at your nearest passport office or clerk of superior court immediately. Non-American citizens need to check with CTO for requirements. **VISA:** A Visa is required. Guidance will be provided.

Participants will cover the costs of passports and visas.

VACCINATIONS: Routine vaccines; COVID-19; yellow fever; hepatitis A; hepatitis B, typhoid, meningitis. Malaria pills. More details provided during the orientation.



AIR TRANSPORTATION: Delta Economy. Participants may upgrade on your own.

BAGGAGE: Two pieces of luggage which should not exceed 50 pounds. Two carry-ons.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS: All hotels will be airconditioned, safe, and have internet access.

Payments received after the deadline date will be subject to \$100.00 administrative fee. We reserve the right to cancel any passenger NOT paid in full 40 days prior to departure. Reinstatement of a passenger is considered a last minute booking.

Last minute booking, 40 days or less prior to departure will have to pay the applicable airfare at the time of booking and \$200.00 to cover administrative cost.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations must be made in writing. Participants who cancel after airline tickets have been purchased will receive airline credit with the carrier. Differences between ticket cost and amount paid will be reconciled and will refunds (if applicable) be made less \$200.00 per person administrative fee. Cancellations made 60 days or less prior to departure will be subject to \$400.00 per person administrative fee. Cancellations received 35 days or less prior to departure have to pay a charge equivalent to 75% of the cost of the basic tour from the Gateway City.
